To all Federation Clubs:

Accompanying this letter is a package of the resolutions adopted by the Federation convention held in August this year. These were submitted by the affiliated clubs and edited by the Resolutions Committee as adopted by the delegates.

I am drawing your attention to Federation policy regarding their use. First, they are not binding on the clubs, but simply to be used at their discretion as needed.

The resolutions can be sent to an organization, government agency, congressional delegation, as well as local targets in the regions of most of the Western states and the Province of British Columbia.

They can also be used when testifying before hearings on matters your club is interested in. It would be productive to read the relevant FWOC resolution, mentioning that the total membership of the affiliated clubs is over 250,000.

This is a lot of political clout.
