program on federal lands; ending commercial logging on federal lands; and wider use of prescribed burning in managing forest lands. They also express opposition to a variety of ill-conceived projects: Yucca Mountain High-Level Nuclear waste repository; filling of San Francisco Bay to expand its airport; oil drilling in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge; expansion of Fort Irwin in California; confined animal feed lots (CAFOs) in Idaho, and re-building a road to the Jarbidge Wilderness in Nevada.

Member clubs would be glad to elaborate on the concerns these resolutions express should you want more information. We appreciate the attention you will give them.
